

CLIMBING MT. ST. HELENA

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Gifford Pinchot National Forest - Mount St. Helens Summit

Overlooking Napa Valley, Mount St. Helena is about the most scenic climbing in the Bay Area. If you're willing to hike there's a ton of trad climbing in the area.
