There are many variations on the staccato theme, including 'close-to-the-keys' staccato, finger staccato, wrist staccato and whole-arm staccato.

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A run may end up consisting of staccato, legato, and overlapping notes. . . When practicing staccato, practice the three (finger, hand, arm) staccatos first before.

"Forearm staccato is used for heavy staccato. You can't use wrist staccato for this because you don't have the arm weight needed to drop your.

For the first three staccato touches, it is best to present them in this order as the Arm staccato: Raise the forearm (elbow to finger tips) approximately six inches.

I pondered these assumptions and their relationship to the practical hands-on knowledge I had acquired in my own analytical excursions and through Arm Staccato observations. Sounds easy put like that doesn't it?

Controlling the tone of a single note is probably just one aspect of a multi-fa Rhythm is also intimately associated with speed. This information is also critical for the piano technician. If you were to sit at the piano and play one Arm Staccato, it seems nearly impossible to alter the tone except for things like staccato, legato, loud, soft.

I would consider that a flying staccato, as it's produced in the wrist rather than you want to practice legato, play some Chopin. The backcheck Arm Staccato not engaged for staccato and the damper cuts off the sound immediately after the note is played.
